# Make Your Own Clutch from Duct Tape!




### You will need:

- A sheet of craft felt (approx 8 1/2 x 11 inches)
- Duct tape in as many colours and/or patterns as you'd like
- scissors
- peel-and-stick Velco®
- Things to decorate with (ribbon, sequins, etc)
- Glue gun (if ribbon and etc is not peel-and-stick)

Step 1: Take a couple of different colours of duct tape and a felt sheet.



Step 2: Cover one side of your felt with strips of duct tape so that a little bit hangs over each side. You can do it however you like, horizontal (shown) vertical, diagonal, etc.

Step 3: Flip your felt and tape creation over.




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
Step 4: Cut the overhanging tape off. Leave the top 1/3 and above.




Step 5: Fold. To do this bring the bottom up to the 2/3 line.



## <u>Step 6</u>: Cut two pieces of tape approximately the same length as the side of the pocket.



<u>Step 7</u>: use one piece per side to tape the pocket closed. Press sticky sides together well to seal.



Step 8: cut away any excess tape (see dotted line). Be careful not to cut the purse itself!



<u>Step 9</u>: Place a strip of tape over each remaining felt edge. Press together well to other tape.



### Step 10: cut along the edge of the felt. Then place peel-and-stick Velcro® where you want the closure



## Step 11: fold the top flap over the pocket. You're done!



# Step 12: Decorate however you want!
